- Event Name:** “24 Hours on Captiva”
- Work Media:** Paintings (oil, watercolor, acrylic, etc.) mixed media, pastels, drawings, fiber art.
- Entry Fee:** \$25 for one or for two works
- Awards:** First, Second, Third and Best Representation of Captiva
- Prerequisites:** Art work must be fitted with taut picture wire 3” below the top of the frame and ready to hang when delivered.
- All paintings must be thoroughly dry.
  - No size limitation but weight must not exceed 50 lbs.
  - Plexiglass instead of glass should be used on works over 16x20, except for pastels.
  - All works shall be newly rendered and not have been shown on Captiva before.
  - All entered art works shall be available for sale.
  - Artists will need to sign a standard contract.
- Timeline:** **Opening Reception: Thurs., Dec. 6<sup>th</sup>, 2018 from 5 to 7;** This reception coincides with Captiva Civic Association’s Holiday Social. Upwards of 200 people attended last year.
- Exhibition runs through Mon, 1pm, Jan.14<sup>th</sup>, 2019; Closed Dec. 25<sup>th</sup> & Jan. 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Open to public Tues., Wed. & Thurs. from 11 to 1 and by appointment.**
- Open Sun. Jan. 13<sup>th</sup> from 11 to 1 after Captiva Chapel By-The-Sea service.
- Entries Accepted:** **Thursday, Nov. 29<sup>th</sup>, from 11 to 1 at the Captiva Civic Center.**
- The juror will be giving a talk on his work and the show plus announce the winners at 2:30 p.m. Nov. 29th. Pick up for artwork not accepted will be Nov.29<sup>th</sup> at 2:30.
- Juror:** David Ruhe
- Miscellaneous:** All artwork shall remain for the exhibit duration, including artwork sold.
- Pickup Artwork:** All works may be picked up Jan. 14<sup>th</sup> from 1 to 3 or by appointment.
- Publicity:** The Captiva Civic Association (CCA) provides publicity in island papers and to its members via postcards and emails. The Sanibel-Captiva Art League (SCAL) publicizes this exhibition to its members.
- Sales:** The Sanibel-Captiva Art League will oversee sales transactions. The buyer will pay the artist directly. A 25% sales fee for all works sold in the exhibit will be paid by the Artist to the CCA within 10 days of the last day of the exhibition.
