Given the general time frame within which to show your work, please do the following:

- Consult the calendar on the SCA site to choose a time period to plan the unloading and hanging of your art:

- Access the exhibiting document on our website to plan which paintings will fit in the available spaces. Go to sancapart.com...Member Displays....SCH
- Hangers (22) are kept in the office so ask at the reception desk for them. The adjustable plastic art hangers attach easily to the decorative molding at the top of the wall. Bring step stool for larger paintings. SCH has a ladder.
- Use only those hangers and put nothing on the walls (ie, nails, sticky putty, tape, etc)
- Attach a sign identifying you as the artist and contact information from one of your paintings in the entrance, not to the wall. (Individual cards and pricing attached to each painting will NOT be done at this venue.)
- You may place your business cards/artist bio in the lobby
- Artist will deal directly with customers concerning any sales. The SCH office should have no interaction
- If you sell any of your work, SCAL appreciates you sharing your good fortune by donating 10% to the Sanibel Community Association
- By hanging your work in this unsecured venue, you signify that you accept that neither Sanibel Community Association and Sanibel Captiva Art League cannot be held liable for any loss you may suffer
