Following last year’s success of our “Deck the Halls” Chapel exhibit, the Captiva Civic Association would like to “Capture Captiva” to kick off theseason. Freshly rendered works depicting Captiva Island, from Blind Pass to Redfish Pass and everything in between,are cordially invited as entries inthis special juried exhibition.

- Name of Event: Capture Captiva
- Work Media: Paintings (oil, watercolor, acrylic, etc.) mixed media, drawings
- Entry Fee: \$20 for one, \$30 for two
- Prerequisites: Artwork must be fitted with taut picture wire 2” below the top of the frame and ready to hang when delivered. All paintings must be thoroughly dry. All works shall be newly rendered and shall not have received 1st, 2nd or 3rd prize in another juried show.Artist must sign a contract.
- Timeline: Opening Reception: Thurs., Dec. 8th, 2016from 5 – 7p.m.
Exhibition runs through Jan. 13th, 2017
Open to public Tues.& Fri.from 11 a.m.-1 p.m.and by appointment
- Entries Accepted: Dec. 1st&2nd, from 10a.m.- 12p.m. at the Captiva Civic Center.
Pick up for artwork not acceptedshall be December 5th, 10 a.m.- noon
- Awards: Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.
- Miscellaneous: All artwork shall remain for the duration of the exhibit, including artworks sold.
- Pickup Artwork: All works may be picked up Jan. 16th from 10 a.m.– 12 p.m. or by appointment.
- Publicity: The Captiva Civic Association will provide publicity in island papers and to its members via postcards and emails.
- Sales: A 25% sales fee for all works sold in the exhibit will be paid by the Artist to the CCA within 10 days of the last show exhibition date.

Exhibition Entry Requirements, Agreement, and Release

1. **Media:** Paintings (including oil, acrylic, watercolor), collage, pastel, mixed media, drawings, original prints (including etchings, wood block, linoleum, lithography, monoprints), batik.
2. **Originality.** All art work must be original. No copies, reprints or work derived from someone else's photo. No classroom or workshop work.
3. Art work must have been created within three years of the receiving date. Art work having received 1st, 2nd, or 3rd prize in any previous show is not eligible.
4. Size Restrictions: None
5. If a canvas is unframed, the canvas must continue around all the edges, with no visible staples.
6. Paintings must be thoroughly dry.
7. Use only picture wire. String, gallery clips, or saw tooth hangers are not acceptable. The wire's hanging point for paintings must be 2 inches below the top of the frame and the wire must be taut. Use tape on both ends of wire.
8. Large paintings on a full sheet of watercolor paper (22x30) or equally large pastels, collages, must be covered with Plexiglas instead of glass, to avoid excessive weight.
9. Artists are welcome to sign up for gallery sitting when the gallery is open to the public.
10. Prize winners are strongly encouraged to be present at awards ceremony on Dec. 8th, 5-7 p.m.
11. The CCA Art Committee reserves the right to reject any work that (a) it deems offensive, (b) creates an unreasonable risk of damage or injury, (c) does not appear to be original, (d) is not practical or reasonable to display (including factors of size, weight, and sufficiency of exhibit space), and (e) does not meet the terms of this prospectus.
12. All artwork must remain hung for the duration of the show. All purchased pieces must remain hung for the duration of the show.
13. **RELEASE and AGREEMENT.** The Captiva Civic Association, and its agents, will exercise the care in respect to the property exhibited as it does in safeguarding its own property, but do not accept responsibility for the loss or damage to the artist's work during the exhibit and related activities. The artist hereby agrees to release and hold CCA, and their agents (including staff and volunteers), harmless from any liability or damage resulting from loss or damage to artist's work arising in any way from or connected to this exhibition or related activities, or from any other loss or damage whatsoever arising from or connected to this show. For purposes of this agreement, the phrase "loss or damage" encompasses, but it is not limited to, theft by third persons, mistaken labeling, damage by a guest or patron, damage by Captiva Civic Association and its agents and volunteers, or damage due to environmental conditions, and injury to artist.

Artist agrees to the terms and provisions of this agreement and further represents that he/she has read and accepted the terms of this agreement.

Financial

The fee to enter this exhibit is \$20 for one, and \$30 for two pieces for members with proof of membership to any of the ACSWF member leagues, payable by cash or check. If not a member of any of the leagues, you may join Sanibel Captiva Art League by accessing the membership form at sancapart.com, or pay the \$30 annual membership fee at receiving.

All work must be for sale. BIG Arts retains 40% of proceeds of sale as commission, and artists are responsible for all applicable income taxes. Work should be priced accordingly.

No work shall be removed until close of show.

Liability

Sanibel Captiva Art League and BIG Arts will make every effort to handle the artist's work with care and to safeguard against loss or damage; however, both organizations will not be held responsible for any loss or damage of submitted work. Insurance is the responsibility of the artist. The artist agrees to hold SCAL and BIG Arts and its agents harmless from any liability for damage resulting from loss or damage to the artist's work. Each entrant must be prepared to show a current membership card from the Sanibel-Captiva Art League, or from a member organization of The Art Council of Southwest Florida. Entry into the show is conditional on the artist signing (and the authorized representative if delivering for the artist) the SCAL release agreement and the Big Arts Exhibitors Contract.

Specifications

Artwork entered must not have been executed by mechanical or digital means, under instruction of another, copied from photos, publications, or the work of another artist.

2-D Art

Paintings must be dry.

Must be 144" or less in perimeter, including frame

Attachment: wire only, with ends taped, hanging point 3" from the top of the frame

Use plexiglass only. No glass on wall hangings.

3-D Art Mounted on a Wall

Must not exceed 24 inches in any direction nor weigh over 15 lbs.

3-D Art Mounted on a Pedestal

Must not exceed 48 inches in height including pedestal, nor exceed 24 inches in width including pedestal, nor weigh over 30 lbs.

Must be on a white pedestal acceptable in appearance and to be provided by the artist if necessary.

Biography

Artists may submit a one-page biography or artist statement for inclusion in a gallery binder
